

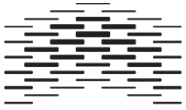

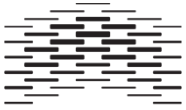




Open access policy at HIOA (2011):

- ..aims to make research results publicly available in the Open Access Institutional Repository to ensure free exchange of ideas in connection with the research at HiOA.
- Journals and editorial series published by HiOA shall follow the principles for OA relating to free access to scientific publications.

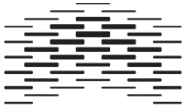




Facilitate so that students and researchers choose OA

- The Publication fund for OA cover processing fees for Open Access publications and open research data in fully Open Access **journals**, Open Access **books** or **open data repositories**.

Open access journals

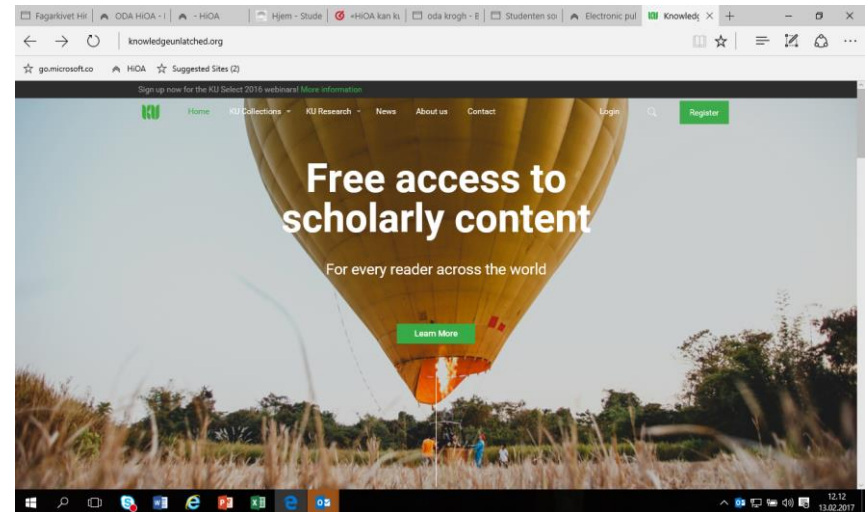
- 12 journals, 11 on level 1, with support from the Research Council of Norway
- The Library offers [technical infrastructure](#) to establish Open Access Journals by using the software Open Journal Systems (OJS).
- Editing boards and at the institutes
- 100.000 downloads in 2015

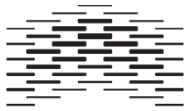




What have we achieved?

- 13,5 % publications in OA-channels
- 90 % of peer-reviewed articles are deposited in CRISTin
- Of these, 50-60% of publications the last 5 years are openly available in ODA



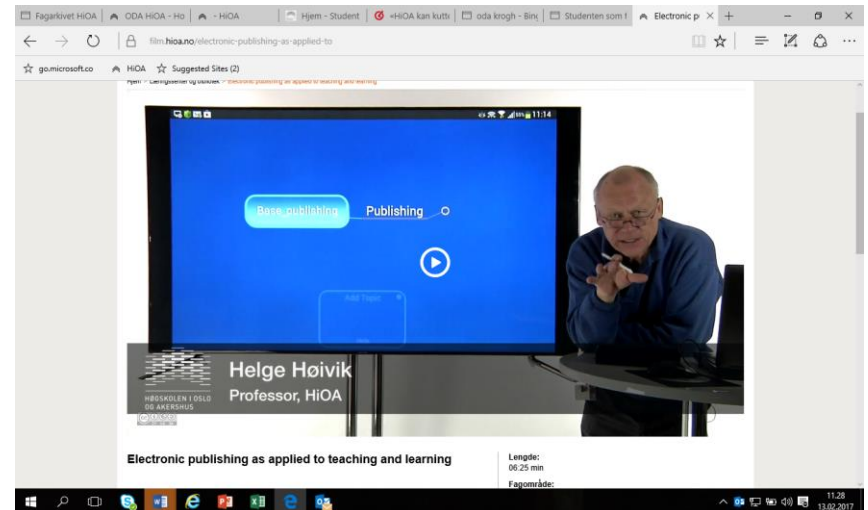


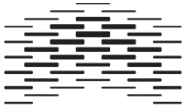
